1. use this Quickstart to prepare for your demo meeting. It includes everything you need to know to get the right virtual machines started and ready to begin showing the solution. Use this quickstart if you are building the demo locally on your own hardware or if you are accessing a pre-built version on the Novell Online Demo System (NODS)

Works through a NetWare to OES2 Consolidation using the new migration tool that's included in OES2 SP1

- The consolidation will migrate users home directory's and create users if they do not exist.
- Also consolidate printers from NetWare to OES

Preparing The Demo

- Start NetWare65UTP first. Allow the machine to fully boot before starting any other Vms.
 - Note that CPU Utilization will be high on the host until VMware Tools loads.
- Once the NetWare server has fully booted, start OES2SP1UTP.
- Once OES2SP1UTP has booted login in as root
- Open Firefox and load iManger, iPrint Printers and Remote Manager in separate tabs

Notes / Issues

The migration tool may fail to navigate the host tree when setting trustee assignments. To overcome this close and reopen the migration tool
