New Single Sign-on Products

Novell recently announced two new single sign-on applications, Novell Single Sign-on (NSSO) Bundle and NDS Authentication Services (NDSAS) 3.0. These products support a variety of applications and operating systems, including Windows NT and 2000, NetWare, and many other applications.

NSSO Bundle combines NSSO 2.0 with v-GO single sign-on technology from Passlogix. This single sign-on technology replaces hard-to-remember User IDs and passwords with a single NDS password. This NDS password extends single sign-on to almost every Windows, web, and host-based application, without requiring any additional programming. NSSO Bundle also provides roam-

ing capabilities, auto-detection of new applications and web sites, and time-out or manual lock of keyboard.

NDSAS 3.0 authenticates users across multiple platforms and legacy applications. You can use NDSAS 3.0 as a standalone product or in conjunction with NSSO Bundle. NDSAS 3.0 redirects authentication requests from various operating systems and applications to eDirectory and then uses the NDS password. NDSAS 3.0 makes intruder access nearly impossible, using features such as intruder detection, password rules, and user disablement.
