

Free registration for GWAVACon surpasses 200 registrants in first two weeks.

With more than two months to go before the event, GWAVACon Munich has surpassed the 200 mark in less than two weeks.

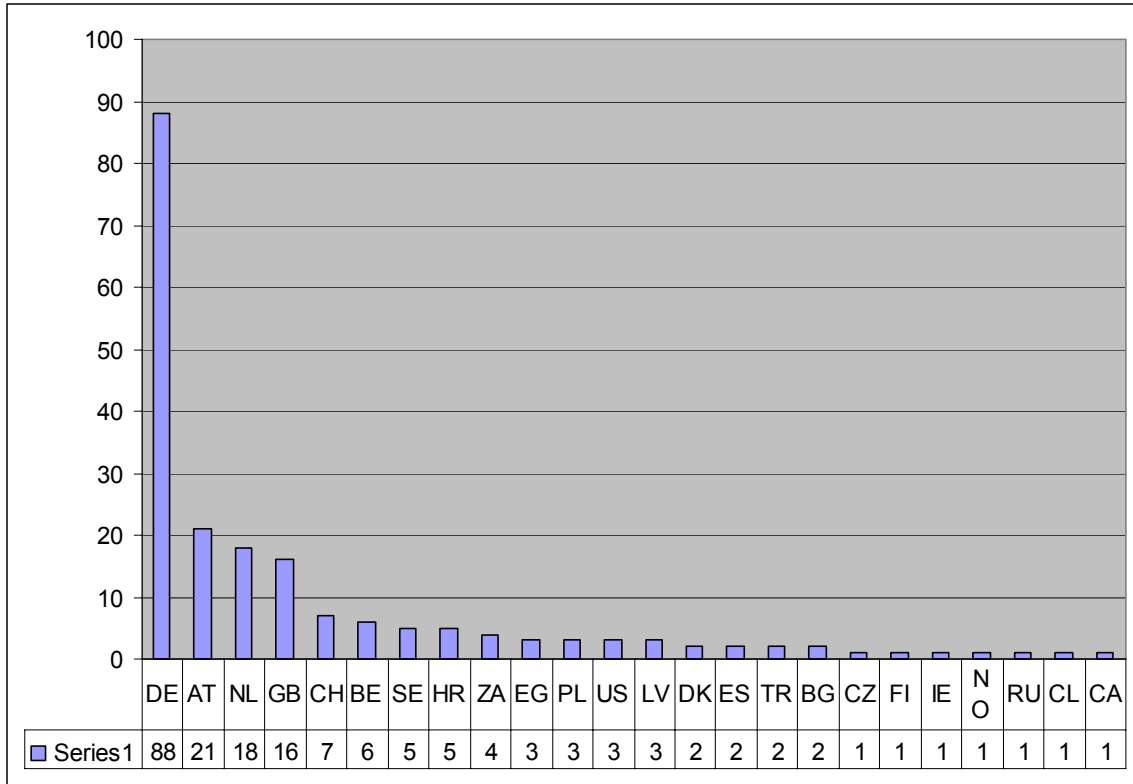
GWAVACon Munich, the largest GroupWise and ZENworks conference in the world, began offering registration on July 12th for free to the first 300 attendees to register. The conference is an independent conference dedicated to Novell GroupWise and ZENworks. Novell will participate with a large number of speakers but the event itself is hosted and presented by GWAVA and other 3rd party vendors who support GroupWise.

For GWAVACon Asia Pacific in June, GWAVA opened up registration at no charge and had 250 people register for the event in less than 10 days. The event was the largest Novell GroupWise conference in Australia in several years.

“We realized that we had a successful formula when so many people were able to attend the GroupWise conference in Sydney” said Richard Bliss, VP of Marketing for GWAVA. “By opening up GWAVACon as free registration early in the planning process, we are pleased that hundreds will be able to attend in Munich.”

GroupWise administrators from more than two dozen different countries have already registered for GWAVACon Europe. Held during Oktoberfest this year in Munich, Germany makes up the largest group, with Austria, The Netherlands, and Great Britain also having respectable numbers of attendees.
