Application Virtualization



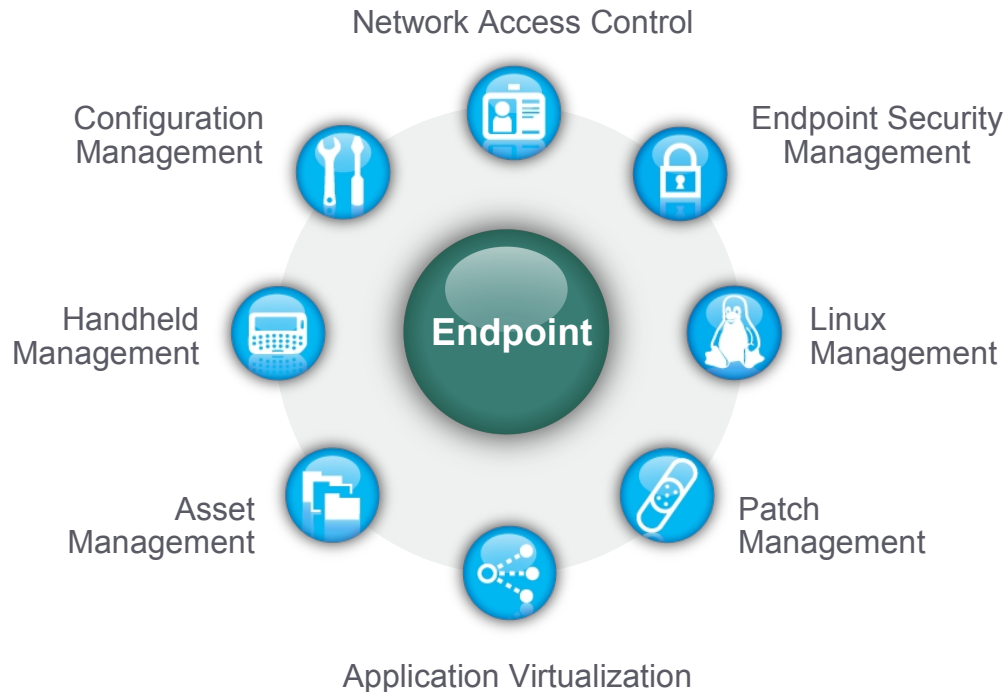
Applications run isolated from host system. Nothing is installed.

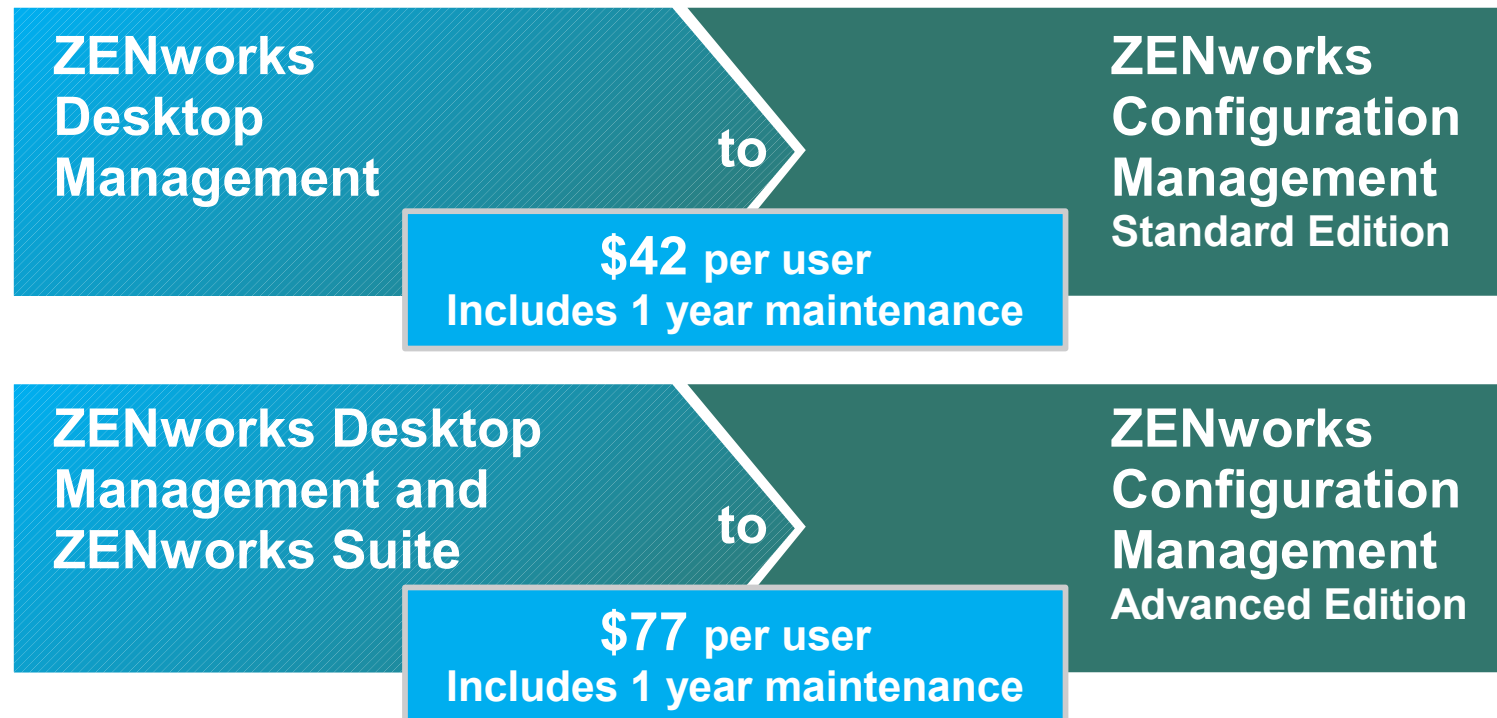
