Functionality Changes in Support Pack One

The management interface in the Velocity Management Suite 2.0 SP1 has been changed to reflect Novell's Web management interfaces, such as that displayed in Novell iManager.

With a few minor exceptions, the panel organization and option names are unchanged.

Screen shots in the context-sensitive help have not been updated.

2 Installing Support Pack One

This section contains information on installing Support Pack One.

Upgrading Not Supported in Beta 1

Upgrading an existing Velocity Management Suite 2.0 management server to SP1 Beta 1 is not supported.

This limitation applies only to the Beta 1 release. The released product will support upgrading.

Management Limitations

For Beta 1 you cannot manage both Excelerator XL 1.0 and Excelerator XL 1.0 SP1 devices in the same group. The released product will not have this limitation.

Installation

Prerequisites

You will need the following:

- A blank, formatted diskette for product licenses
- A CD burner and one blank writable CD

Procedure

To install Support Pack One, complete the following steps:

- 1 Browse to beta.novell.com > click Public Beta > enter your name and e-mail address.
- 2 In the drop-down list, select Velocity Management Suite 2.0 Support Pack 1.
- 3 Select View Downloads/Updates.
- 4 Download the ISO image and the license zip files shown to your workstation's hard drive.
- 5 Using your CD burner software, create an installation CD from the ISO image.
- 6 Unzip the license zip file to the blank diskette.
- 7 Following the instructions in [Installing Velocity Management Suite 2.0](#) in the *Volera Velocity Management Suite Getting Started Guide*.
