Satellite Requirements

Ensure that the ZENworks version of the Satellite Server supports both the current Linux version and the target Linux version.

After upgrading the OS, if the `novell-zenworks-libsolv-helpers-<version>.rpm` is not installed, you need to manually install the RPM by executing the `rpm -Uvh novell-zenworks-libsolv-helpers-<version>.rpm` command.
