1.2 ZENworks Installer

The new ZENworks installer provides a seamless user experience in deploying ZENworks. Using this new installer, you can perform the following:

- Create a new Management Zone (Appliance Only)
- Add a new Primary Server (at ZENworks 23.4 version) to an existing Management Zone.

ZENworks 23.4 supports Windows, Linux, and Appliance. Setting-up a new ZENworks Management Zone with Windows or Linux server using ZENworks 23.4 Installer is not supported as the ZENworks 23.4 does not include an ISO based installer. However, you can use ZENworks 23.4 Appliance to setup a new zone.

If you want to setup a new zone using Windows or Linux Servers, you can use ZENworks 2020 Update 2 and then apply ZENworks 23.4 system update. The ZENworks 2020 Update 2 can be downloaded from Licensing and Downloads site.

1.3 Platform Support

1.4 Updating to ZENworks 23.4

The current release does not support fresh installation. To update to ZENworks 23.4, ensure that your zone is in ZENworks 2020 Update 2, ZENworks 2020 Update 3, or ZENworks 23.3. For instructions on downloading and deploying ZENworks 23.4, see the ZENworks System Updates Reference guide.

While updating a Vertica enabled zone to ZENworks 23.4, a new pre-requisite check is introduced to verify the Vertica version in the zone. If the version is lower than Vertica 23.3, then upgrade to the latest version by using the Vertica Upgrade tool. After upgrading Vertica, reinitiate the system update. For more information, see Upgrading Vertica in the ZENworks Vertica Guide.

1.5 Patch Management Reports

ZENworks and Vertica Patch domains are enhanced to support Advance Patch Feed. Patch predefined (canned), ad-hoc patch reports in ZENworks and Vertica Patch domains are enhanced to support the Advanced Patch Management.

To get the latest domain updates, after updating to ZENworks 23.4, ensure that you reconfigure ZENworks Reporting Server. For more information, see Reconfiguring ZENworks Reporting Appliance in the ZENworks Reporting Appliance Deployment and Administration Reference.

Users in the old Patch feed will not be able to generate reports after reconfiguring ZENworks Reporting with ZENworks 23.4.

1.6 General ZENworks Enhancements

ZENworks collects hardware inventory data from Windows 10 devices to display the devices which are ready for Windows 11 upgrade, through a new pre-defined report and additionally through custom inventory reports. Vertica Upgrade Tool to Update Vertica Database

A new Vertica upgrade tool is introduced. You can upgrade the Vertica database using the Vertica Upgrade tool. This tool allows the Database Administrators to upgrade the Vertica database packaged with the ZENworks appliances. Upgrading Vertica will add-in new features and bug fixes with enhanced security.

This tool is a stand-alone tool and includes all the required Vertica RPMs for the upgrade process. You can use this tool to upgrade the Vertica database, irrespective of the ZENworks version.

Content Download Continues During Network/Location Switching

A new default behavior is introduced for content download during location or network environment change. As per this new behavior when you change location during content download, the download still continues even if the system requirement for the content fails in the new location. For this purpose, two new registry keys and one system variable is introduced:

• Registry Keys:

TimeToWaitBeforeLocationSwitch HonorLocationChangeForContentDownload

• System Variable:

IGNORE REQ FOR DOWNLOAD RESUME

New Buttons added to Manage Folder Views in ZAPP

Two new buttons, (All) and (Favorite), added to display the bundles in both tree view or non-tree view. Now you can view the favorite bundles without navigating the tree view structure by clicking the icon displayed at the top.

Also, a * (Clear Search) icon is added to the **Search Applications** field. You can click the * icon displayed in the Search Applications field to clear the search criteria.

1.7 macOS MDM

macOS and Apple Universal Apps

Distributing VPP Apps

Retiring and Unretiring Devices

You can now retire or unretire Mac MDM devices. If you retire a workstation device, the selected device is retired from the ZENworks zone. If you unretire the device in the future, its assignments are restored. For more information, see Device Removal and Retirement in the ZENworks Mac MDM Reference guide.

Deleting Devices

Deleting a macOS MDM device, removes the selected device from your ZENworks system, its GUID is deleted, and all bundle assignments are removed. For more information, see Device Removal and Retirement in the ZENworks Mac MDM Reference guide.

Unenrolling Mac MDM Device via Quick Task

Automatically Record the Remote Sessions
